## **Objectives**

To develop an integrated, state-wide Aboriginal workforce marketing and communications strategy, to support increasing the representation of Aboriginal people who work in the WA health system in all disciplines across all levels. The strategy will enable:

- streamlining of the multiple workplace pathways, attracting and guiding recruits into WA Health as a workplace of choice through targeted and culturally informed avenues.
- the strengthening of the WA health system culture to recognise and understand the important role of Aboriginal employees to facilitate in retention of staff
- and support the progress towards achieving the aspirational target to increase the percentage of Aboriginal people in the workforce to 3.2% by 2026.




#### **Mentors**




